

# **CURRENT PLANNED WORKS**

With the colder weather hopefully behind us, and the brighter mornings beginning, we are approaching the halfway mark with the Public Realm works.

The paving works are now completed along the West Footway heading towards the Church.

Northstone Ltd are currently laying the concrete base for the paving works within the Market Square and paving will start imminently. Over the next few weeks residents and businesses will begin to see the paving detail take shape within the Square.

Northstone's Civils Team have begun the footway works on the top of the scheme outside the Eurospar and pedestrian access to the footways will be maintained. These works will move from one side to the other to minimise disruption as much as possible.



#### **SEATING**

With a laid-back style, the new seating to be installed in Market Square is designed to be inviting. It's sloping backrest conveys a feeling of relaxation, with an underlying strength in its serenity coming from the combination of hardwood slats and cast iron support.













## Schedule of Works



Phase 4 - Meetinghouse Street June 2024-July 2024

Widening of footpaths / Better pedestrian connectivity / Improved street lighting / Resurfacing footpaths with sustainable materials / The incorporation of street furniture / Planting / Redesigning the car park within Market Square to create a usable civic space

# Scope of scheme

Market Square / Castle Street / Ferry Street / High Street / Meeting House Street.

The Scheme Contractor, Northstone Ltd, will liaise with all of the residents and businesses within the scope of the scheme to try and reduce disruption during the period of works. Those traders and residents directly affected will be contacted by the contractor prior to works commencing.
